

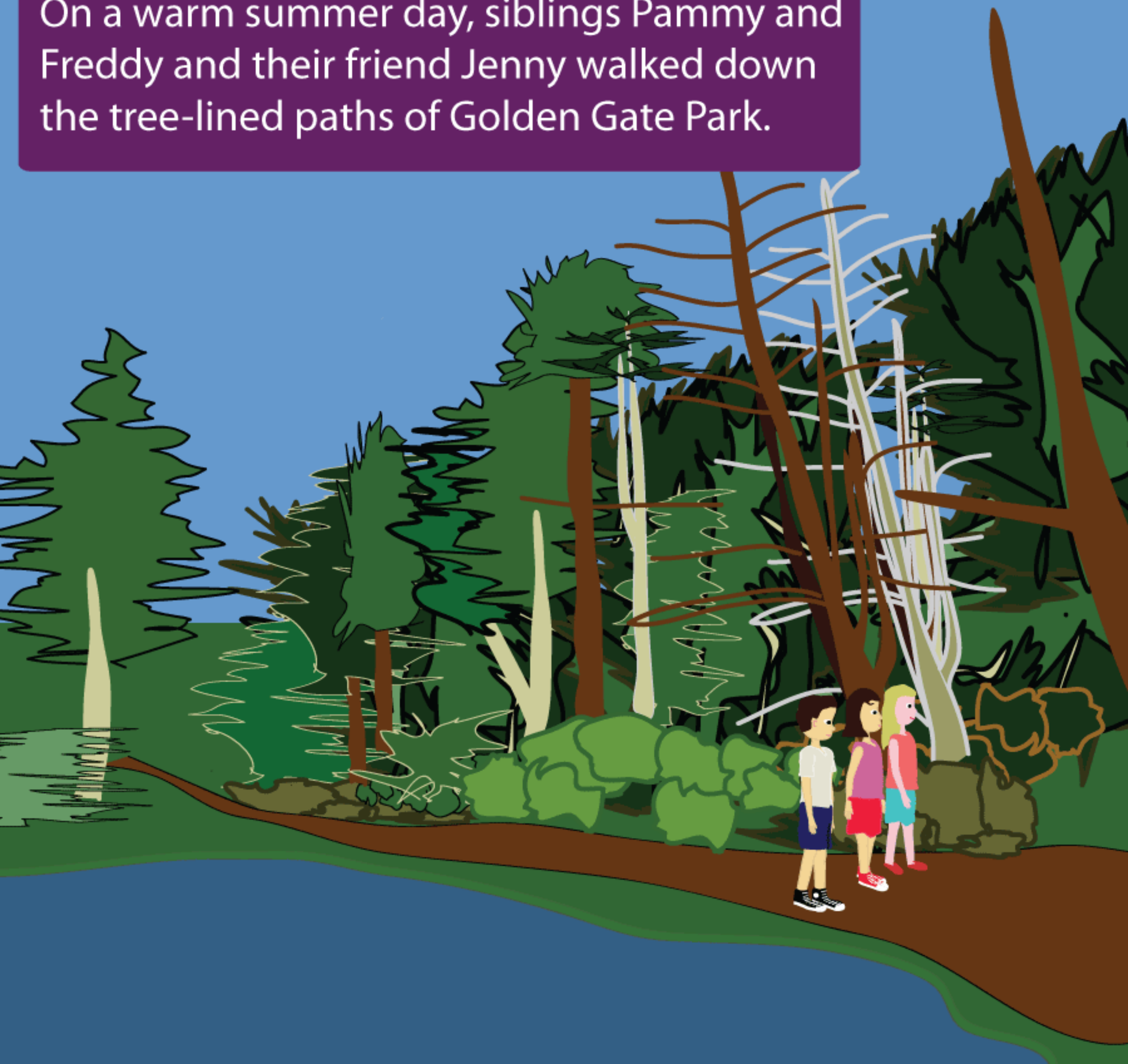

It was going to be a cold night so Pammy wanted to take them home.

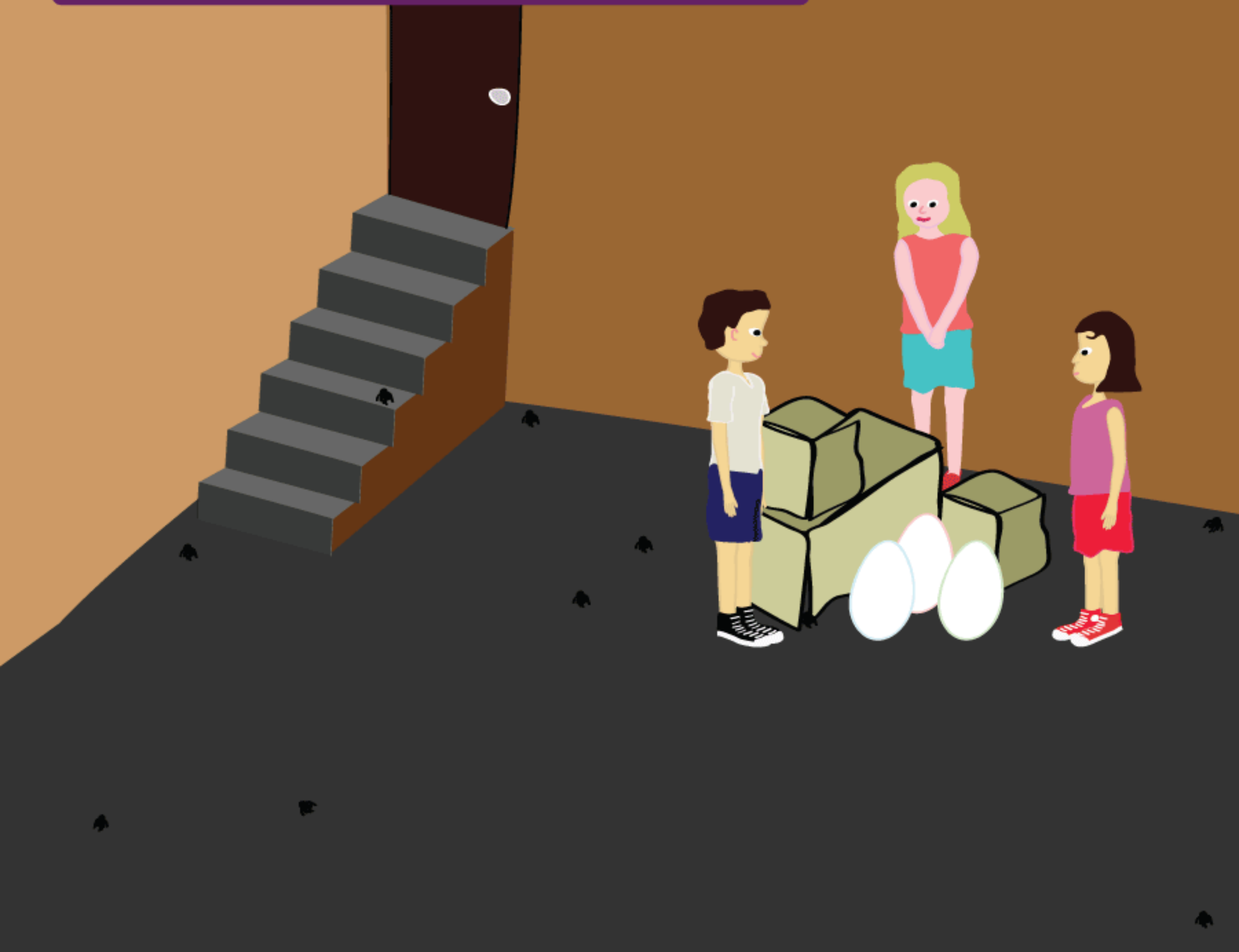


Pammy was sure they could take good care of the eggs.



So, Pammy, Freddy and Jenny carried the eggs home with them. They took extra care when walking because the eggs were big and heavy.

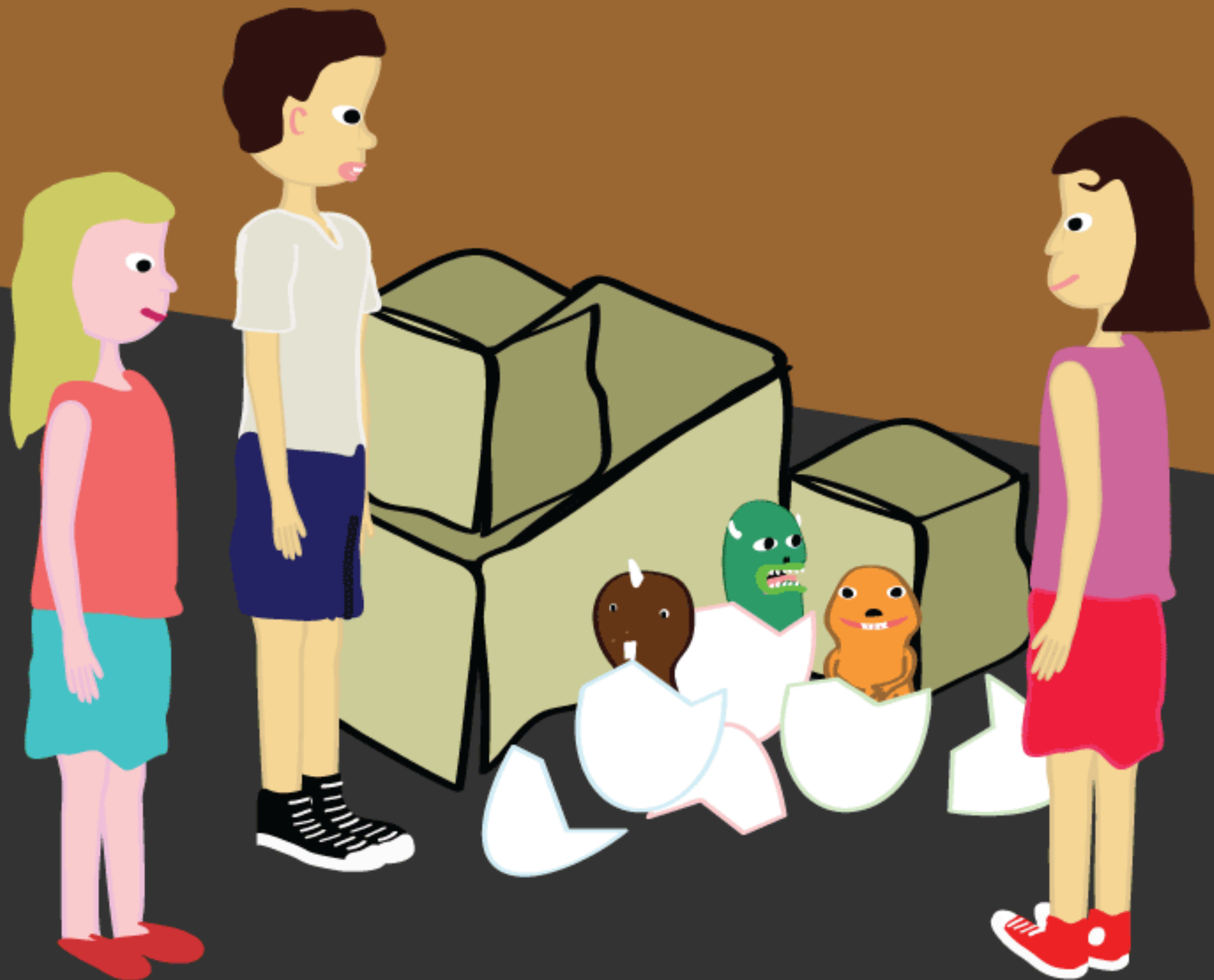
They hid the eggs in the basement of their apartment building. No one went down there because it had so many spiders.

Pammy, Freddy and Jenny helped by tasting all the dishes the monsters cooked up.

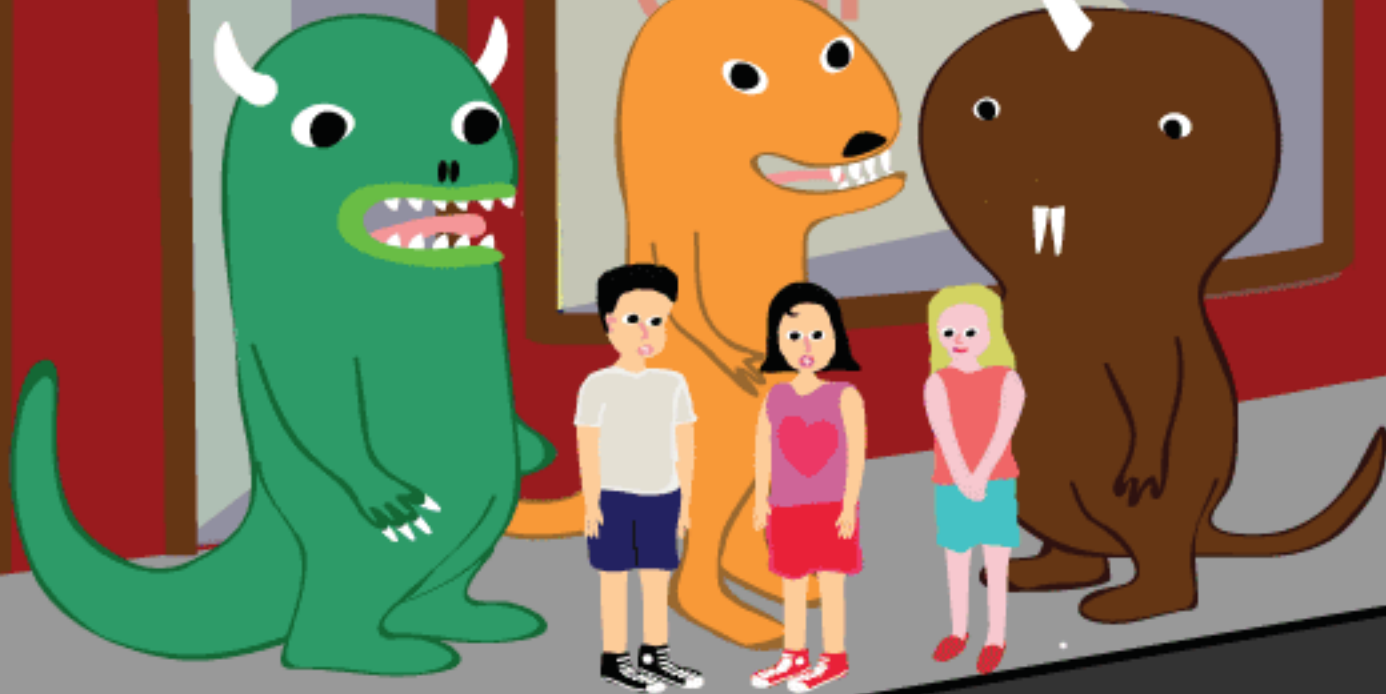


Together they rented an empty store and worked all day and all night getting the place ready.

Monsters Feeding

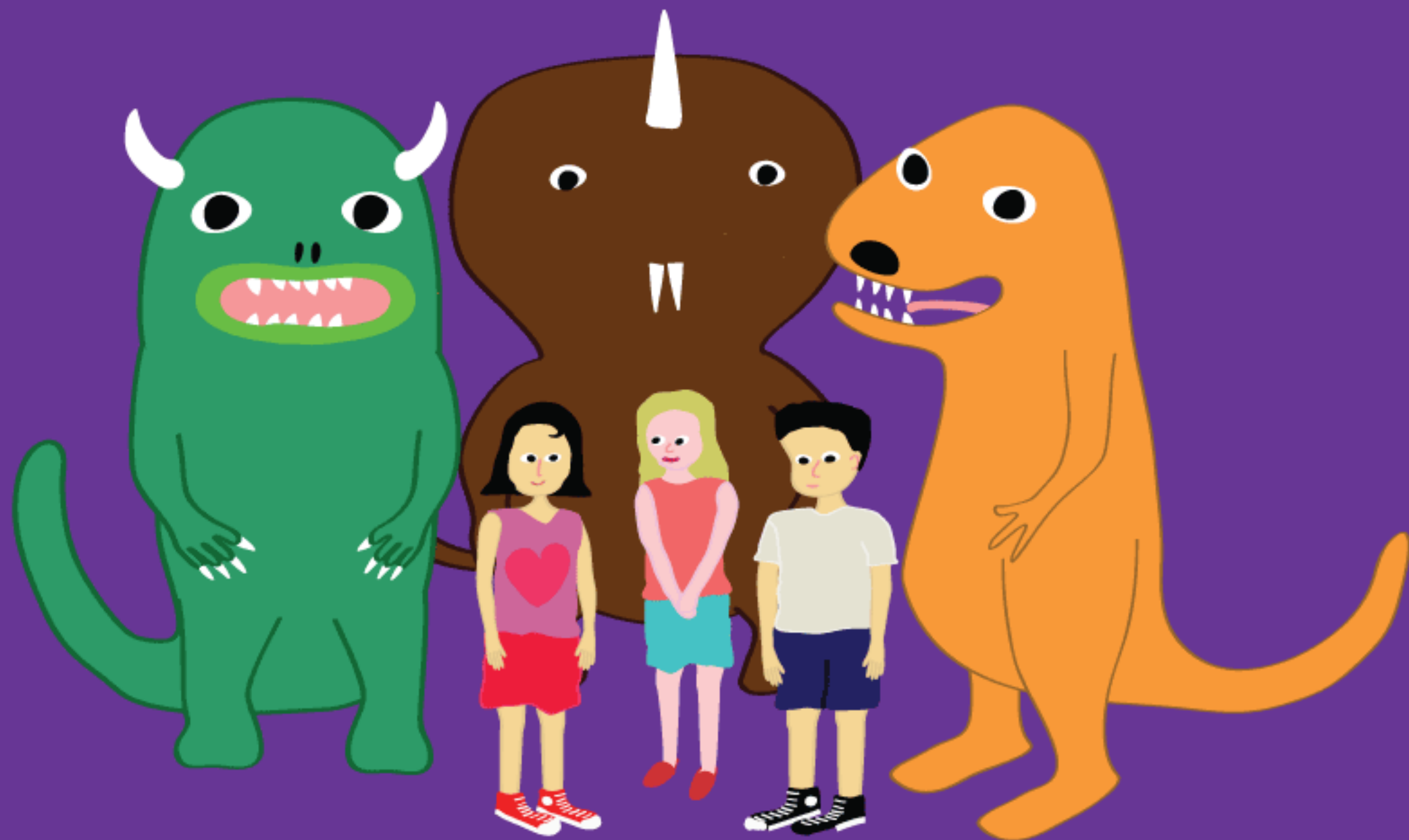


The monsters' restaurant became so popular that the line to get in got longer and longer.
