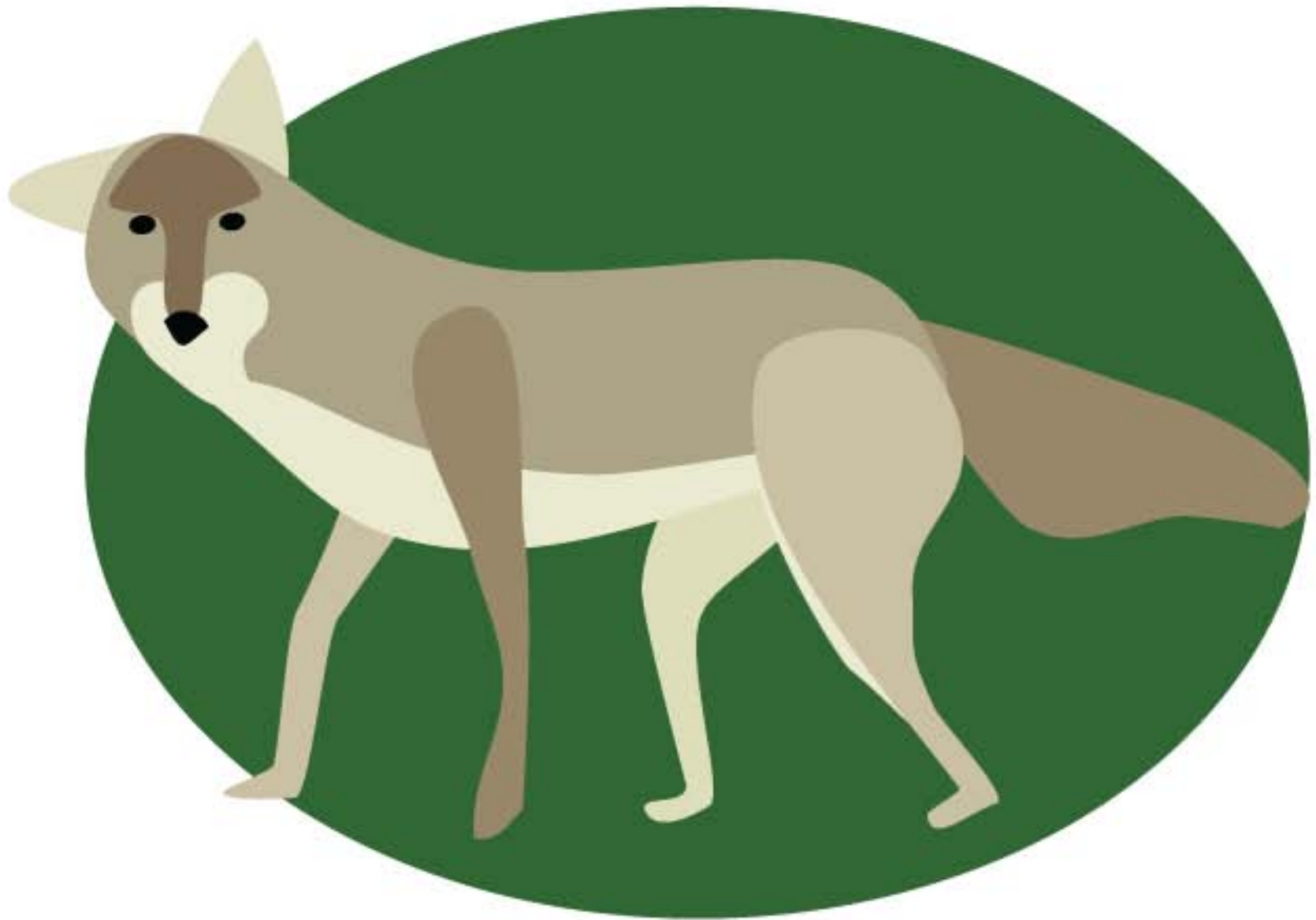
**A** is for an alligator

you.

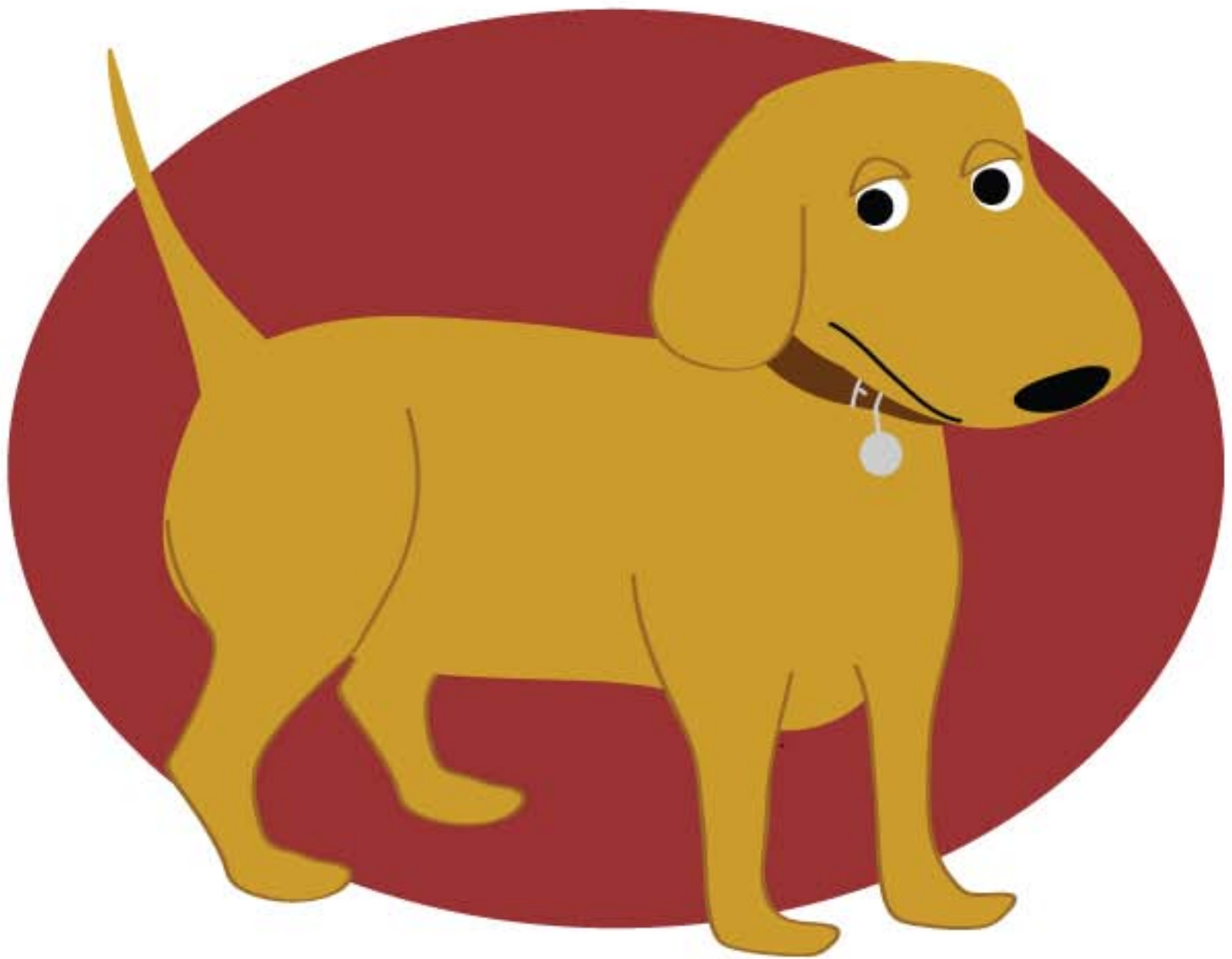


C is for a coyote

carrot.

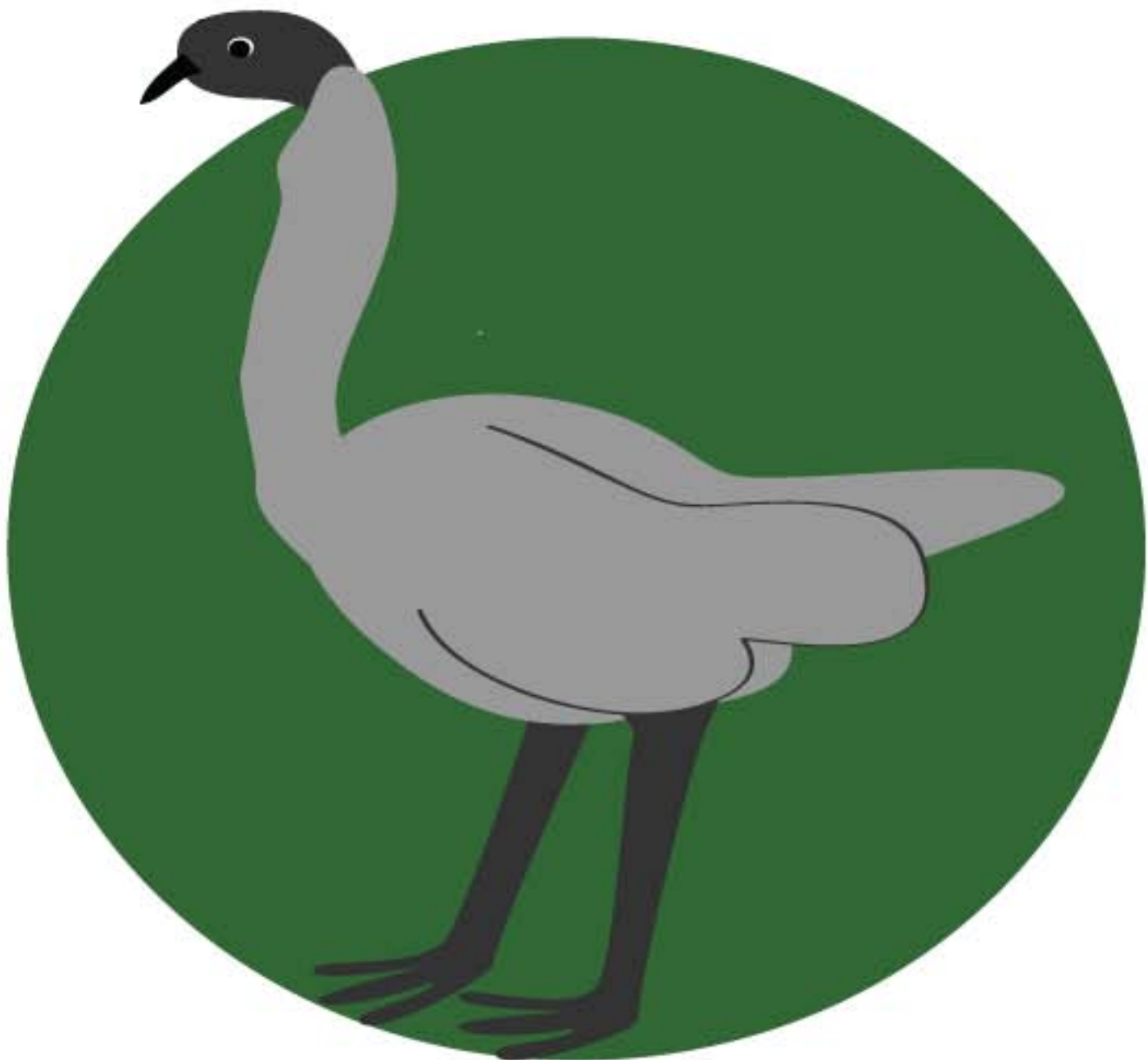




**D** is a dog

flowers.



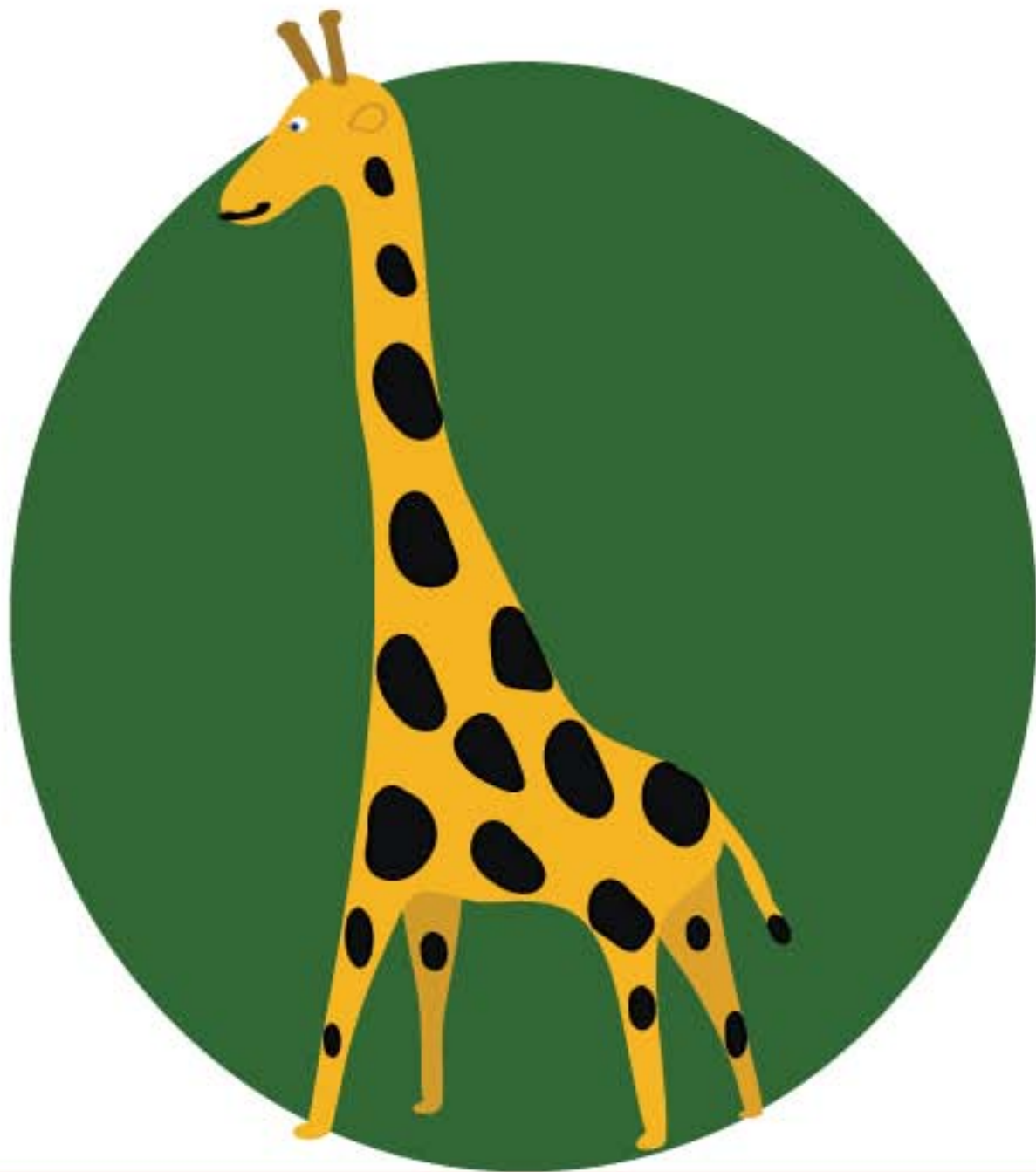
**E** is for a emu

forest.

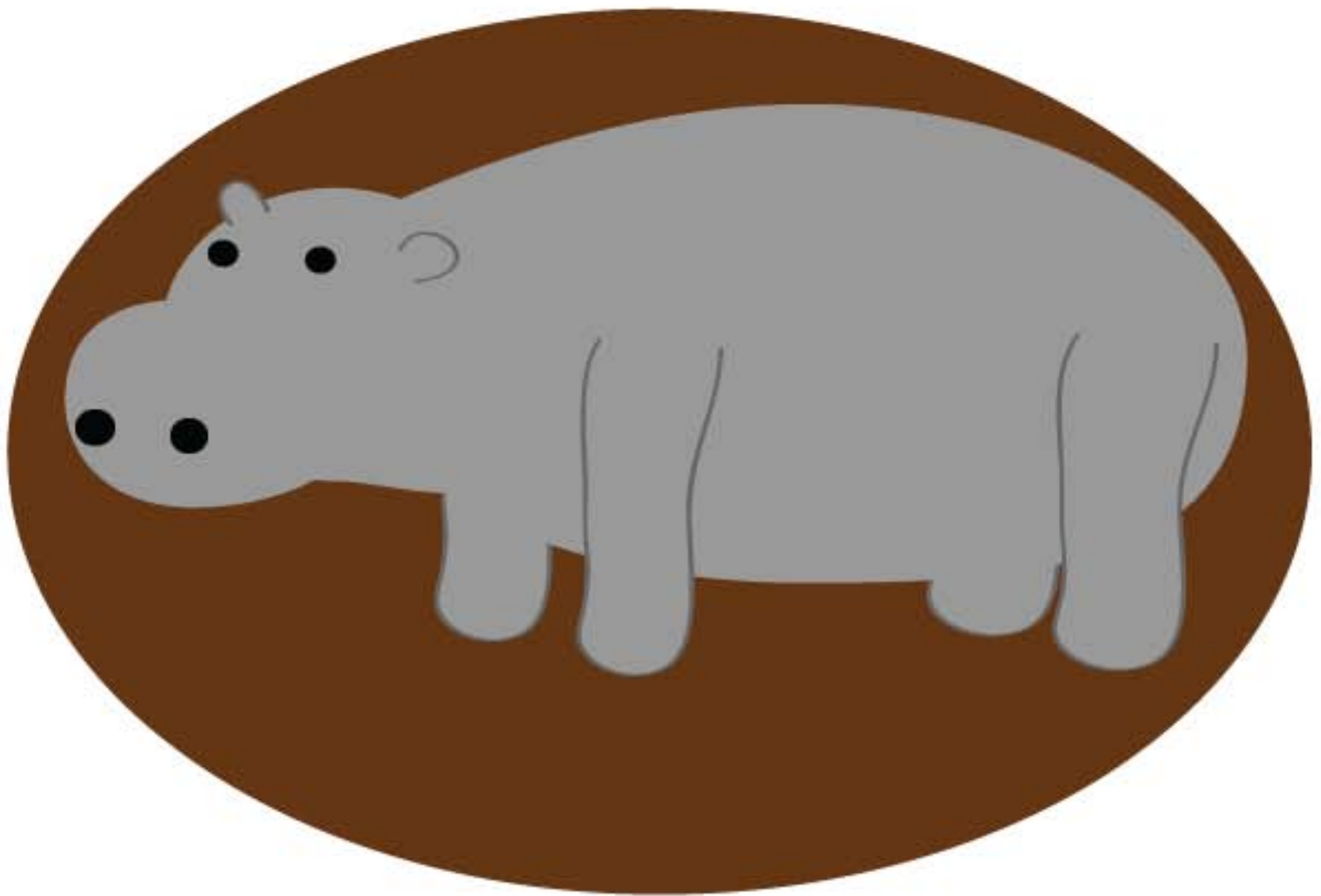


**G** is for a giraffe

gaggle of geese.





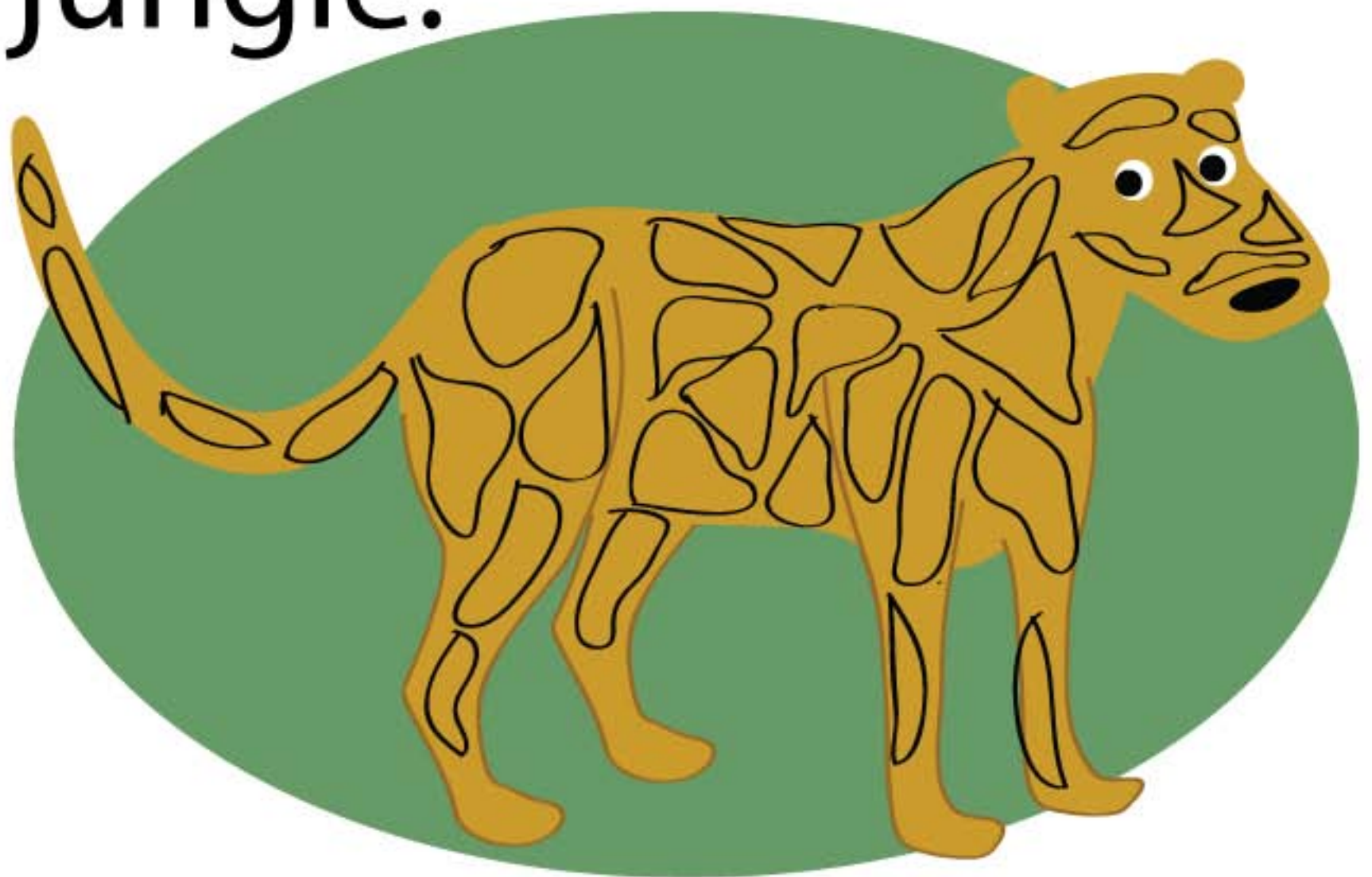
**H** is for a hippopotamus

jungle.

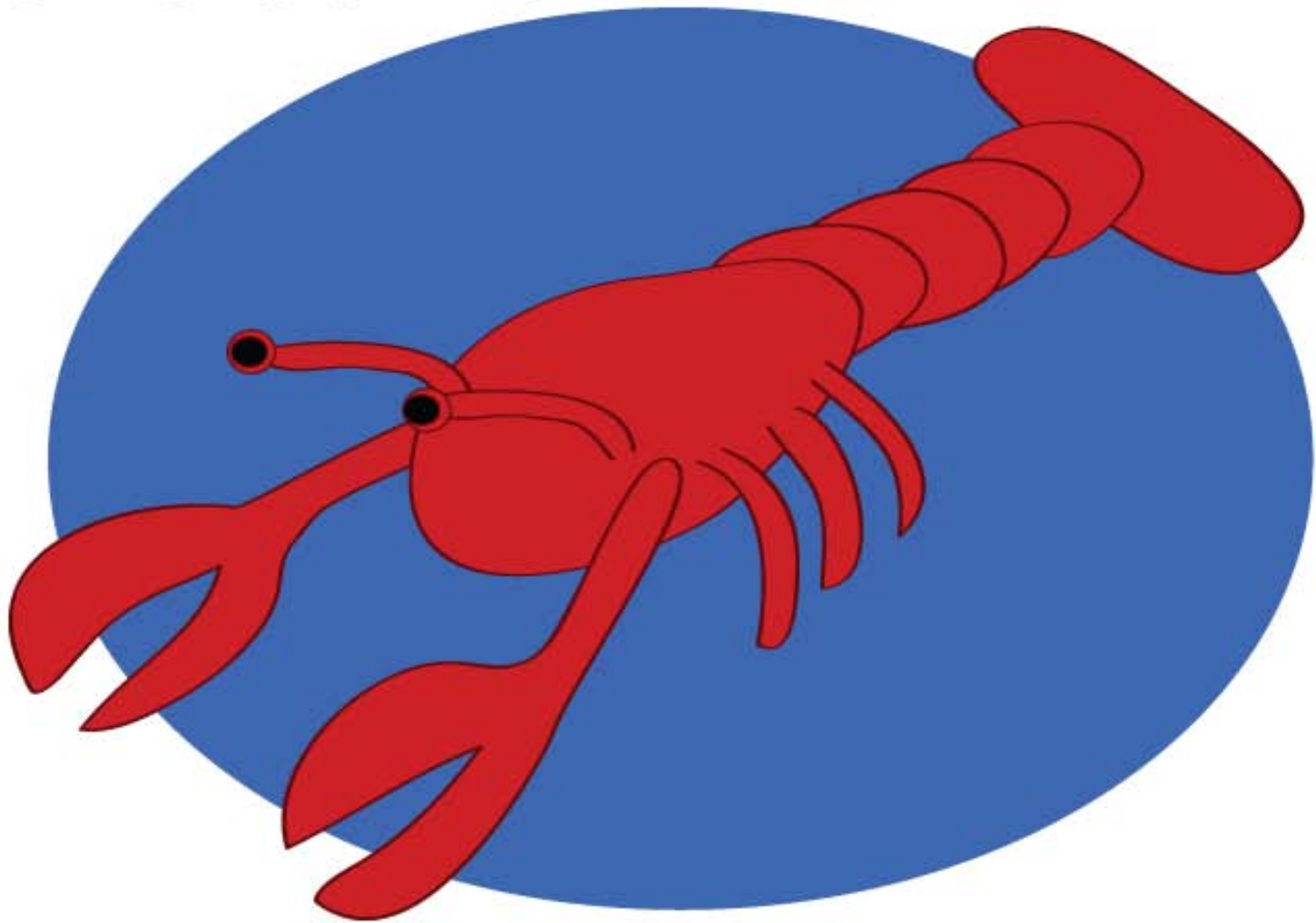


**K** is for a kangaroo

the dark.

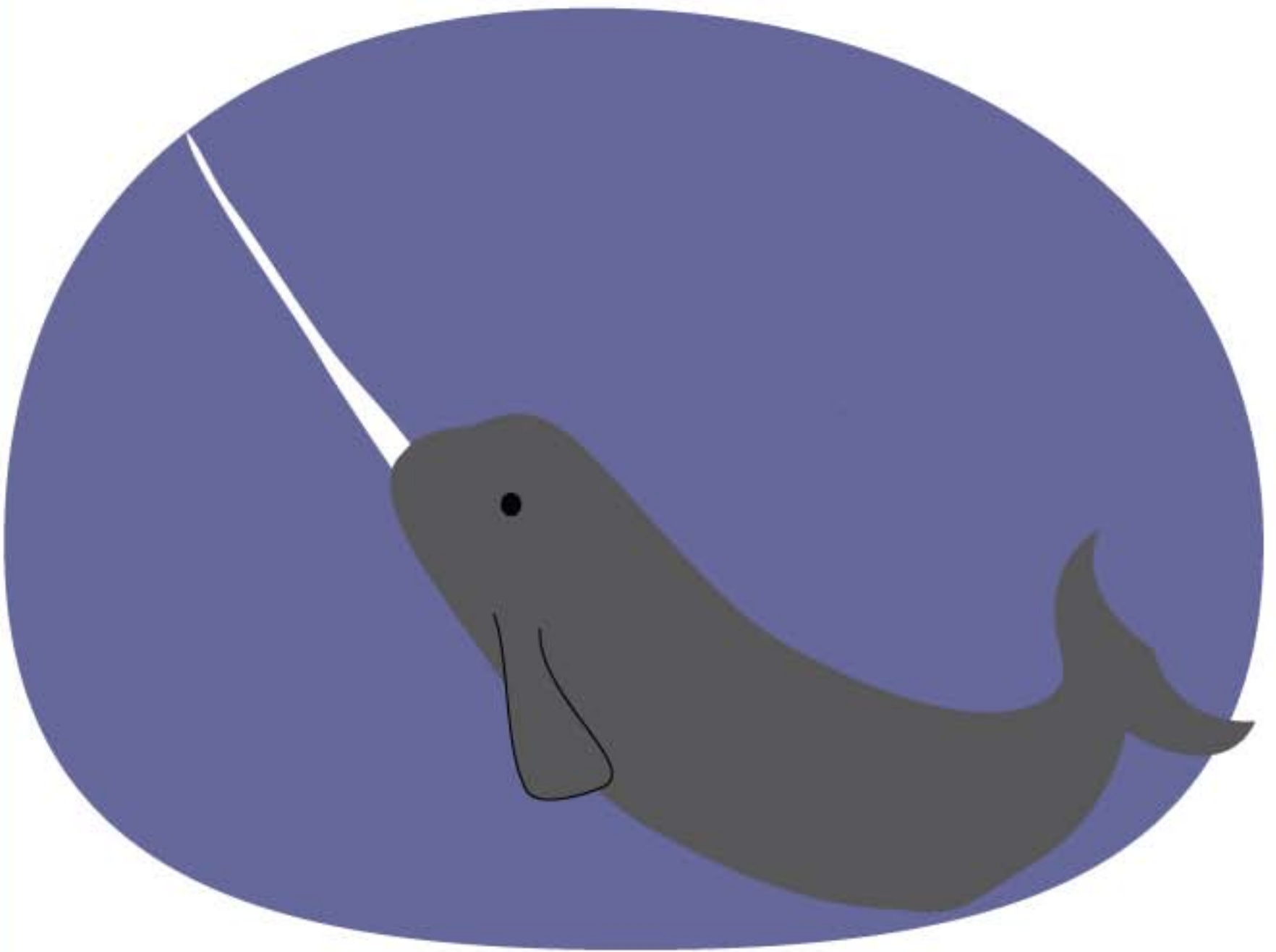




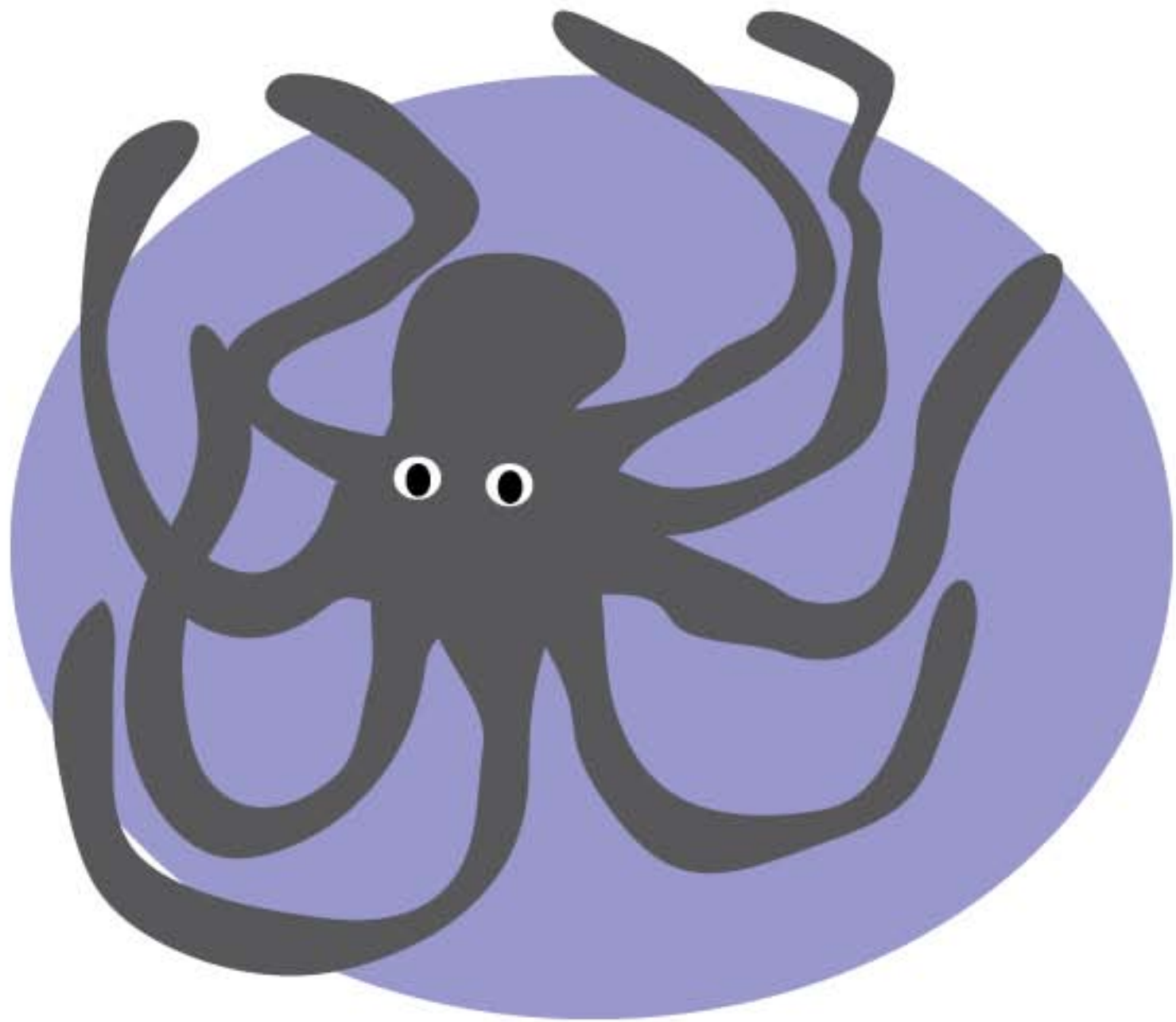
**M** is for a mongoose  
merrily making mischief.



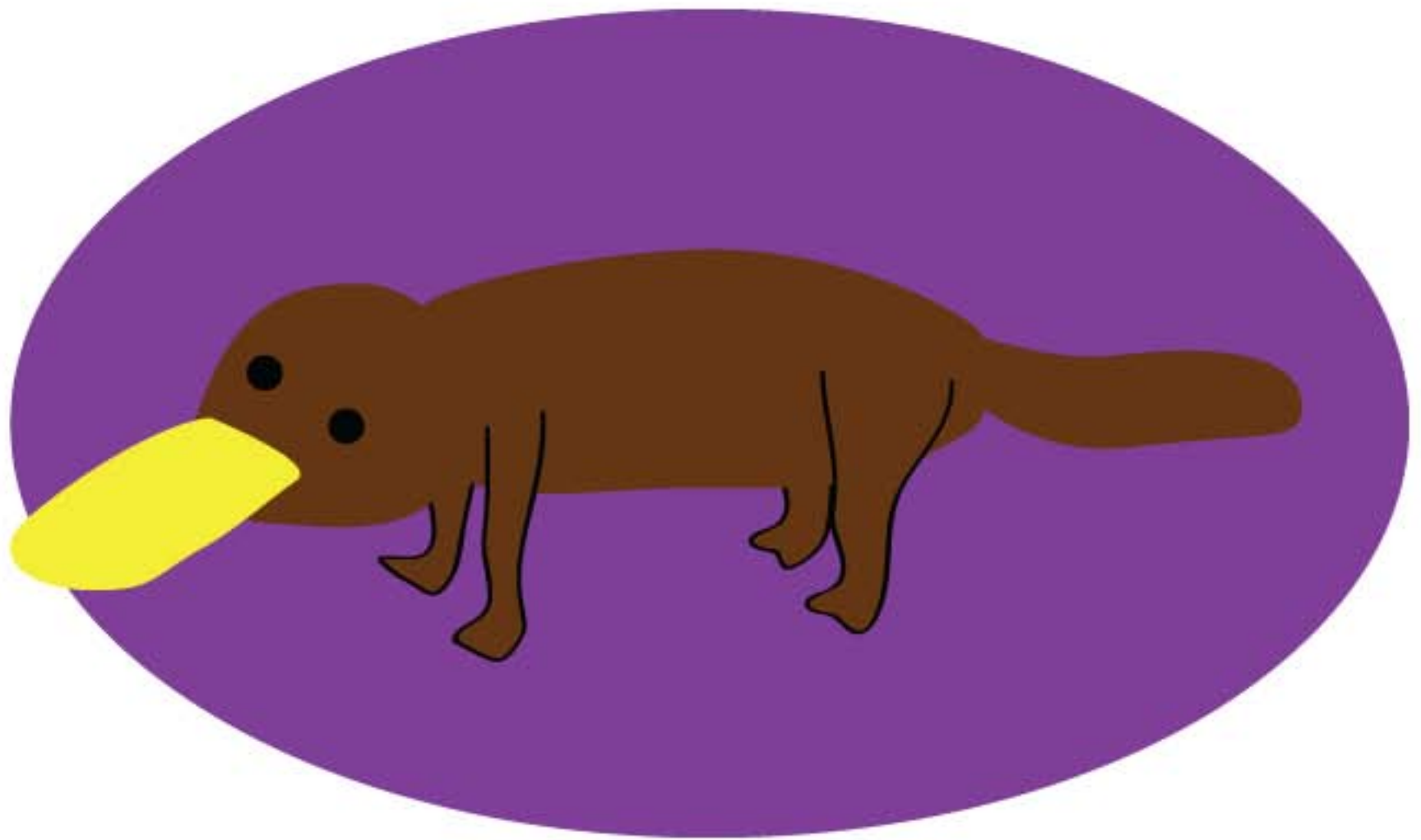
**N** is for a narwhal

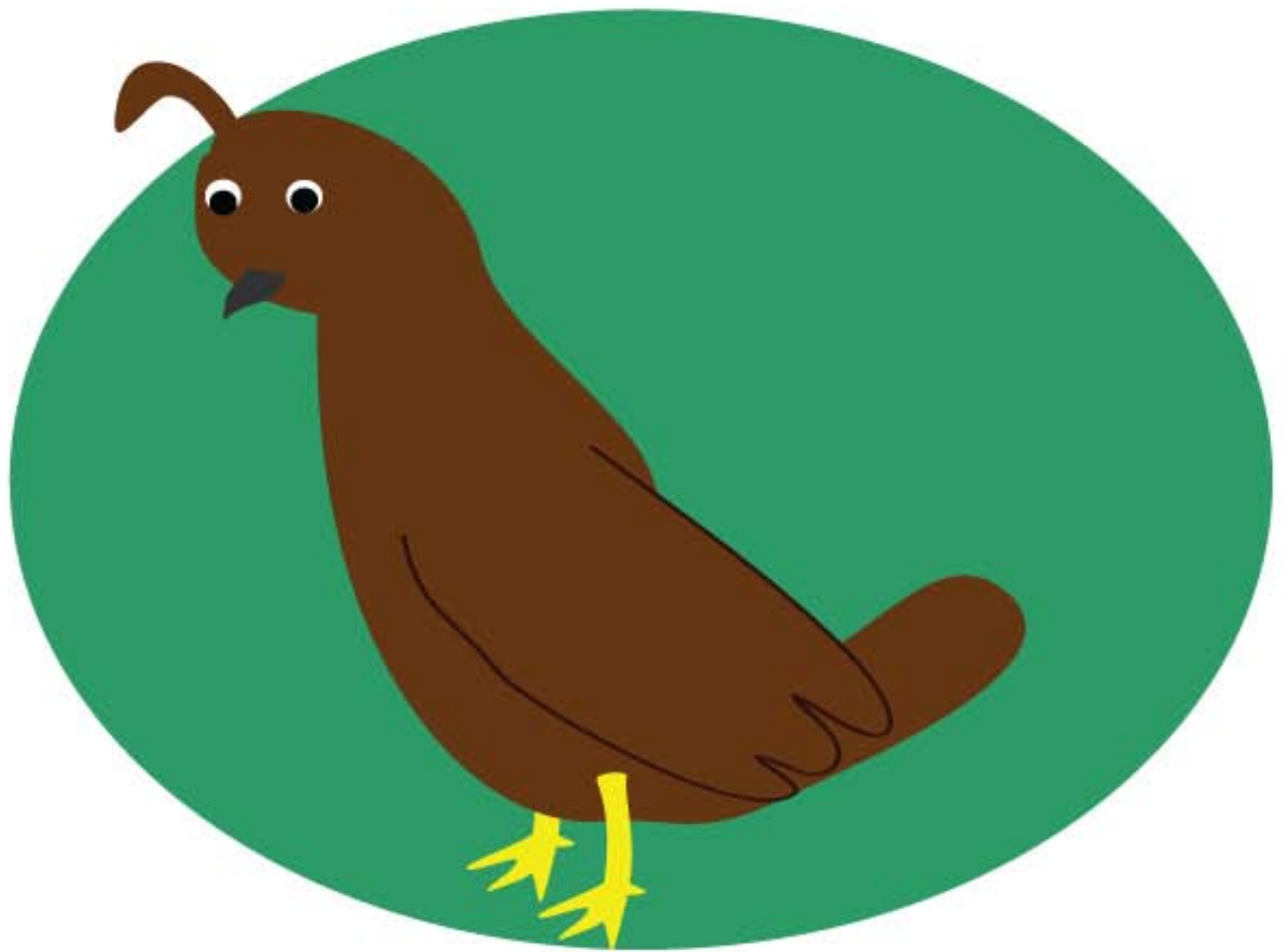
O is for a octopus

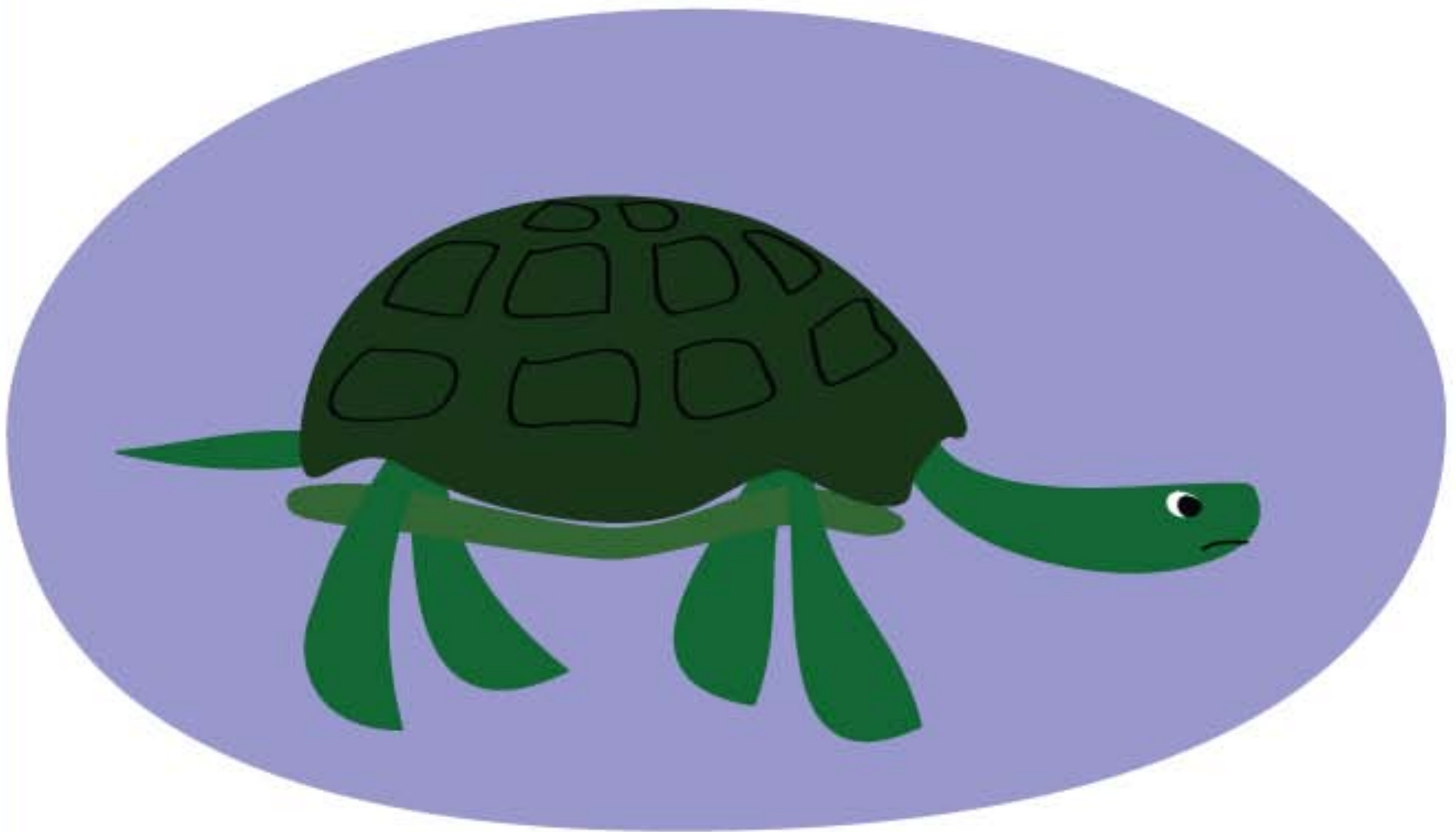
**R** is for a rabbit

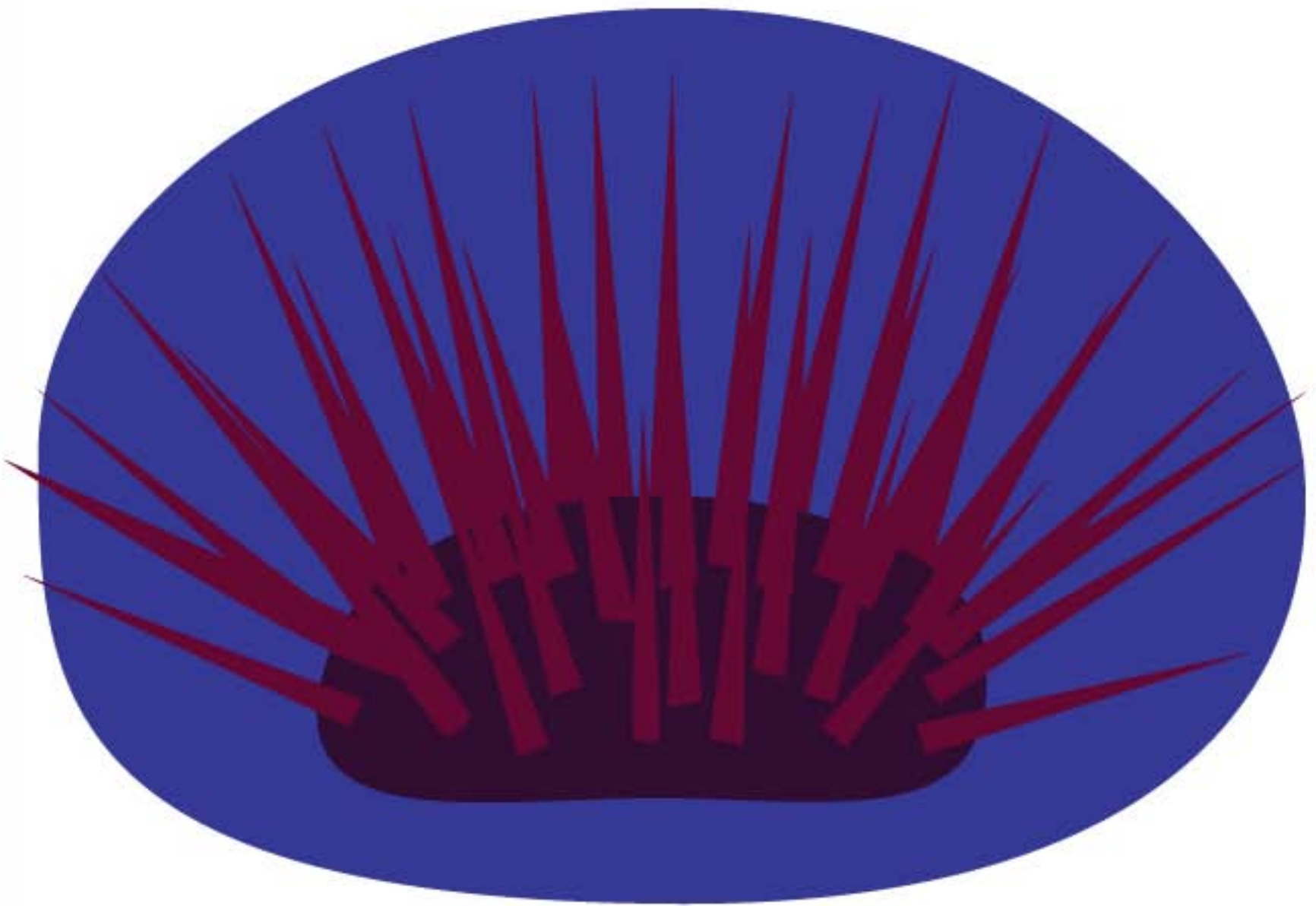
S is for a squirrel

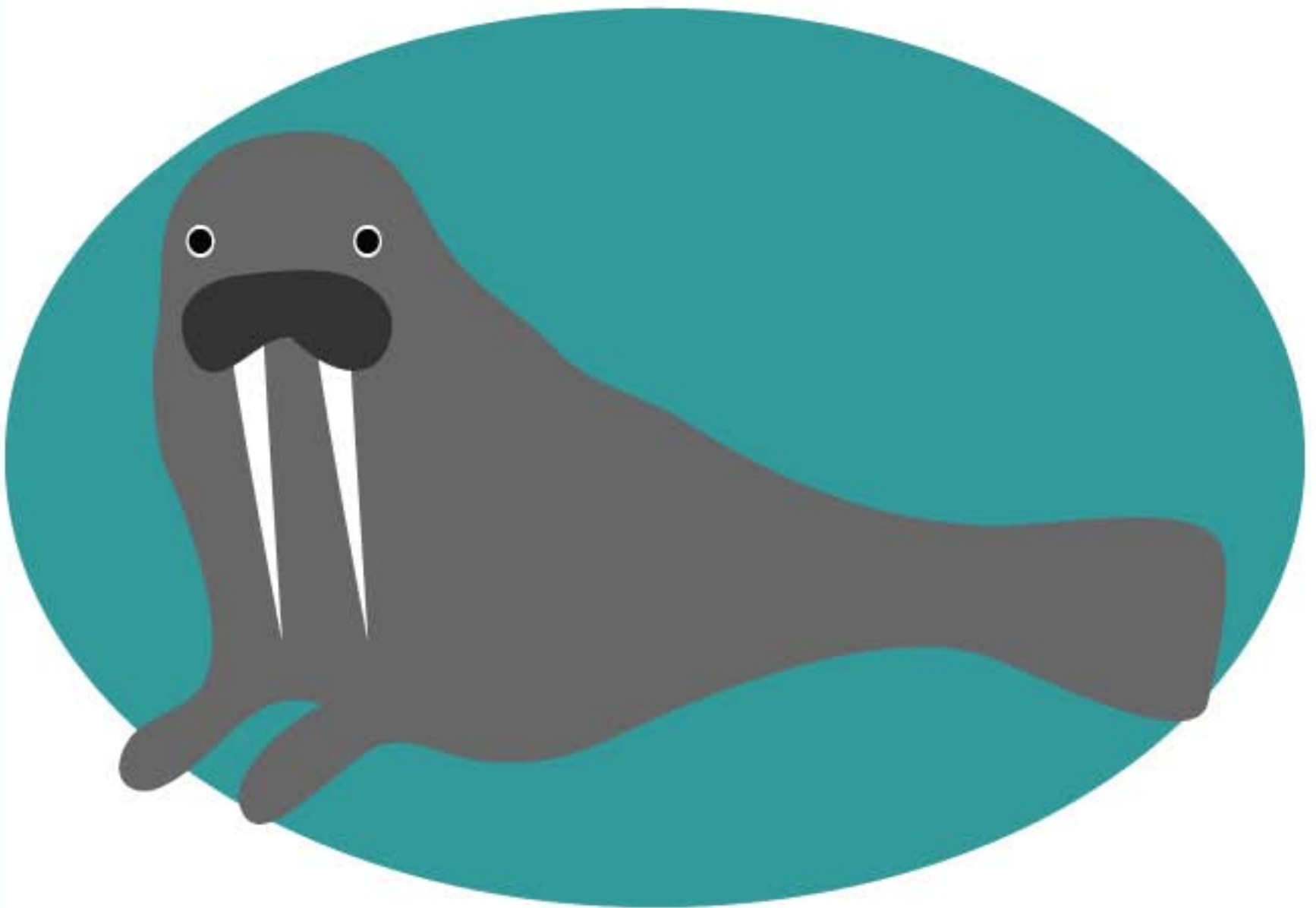

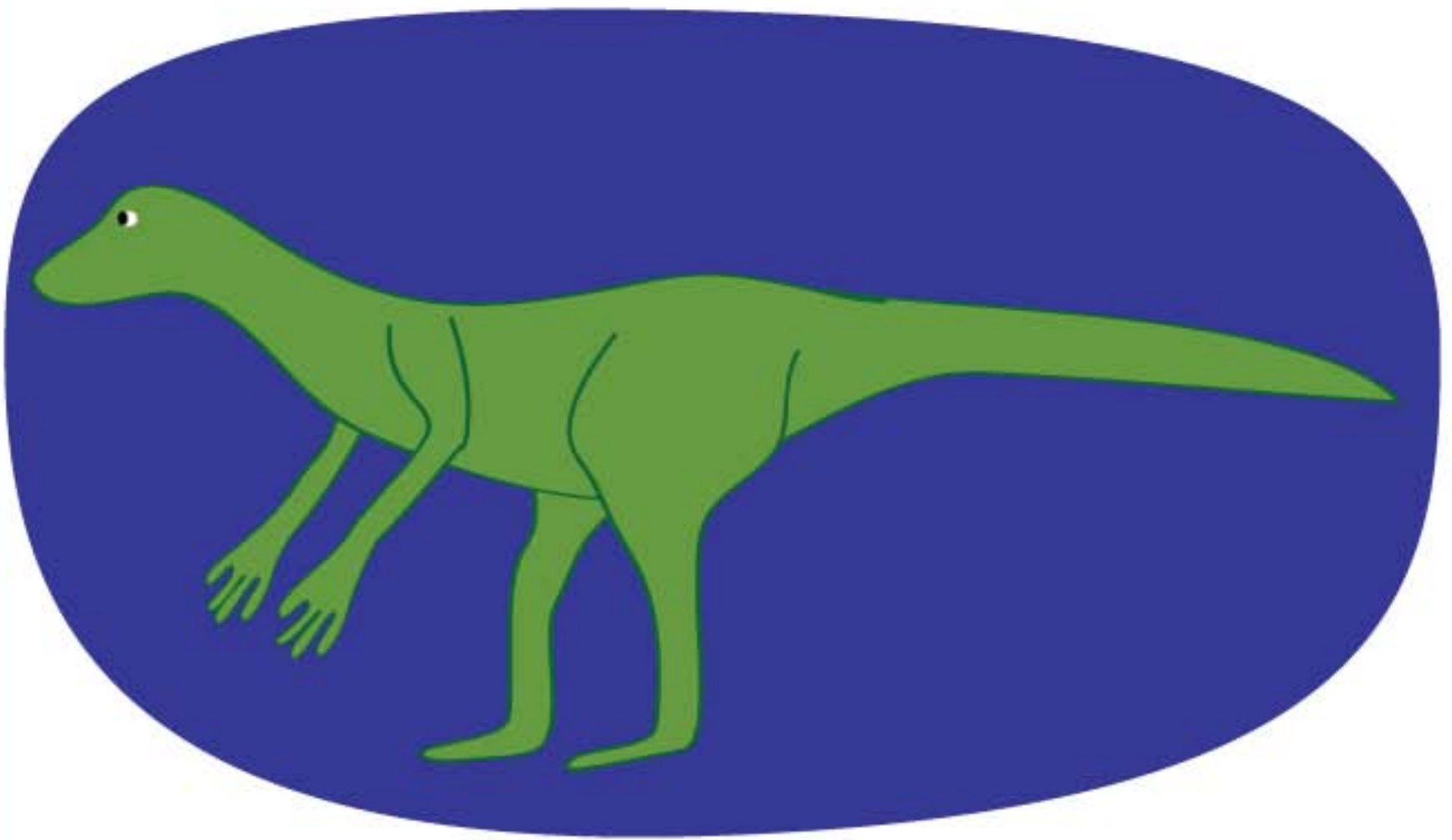
