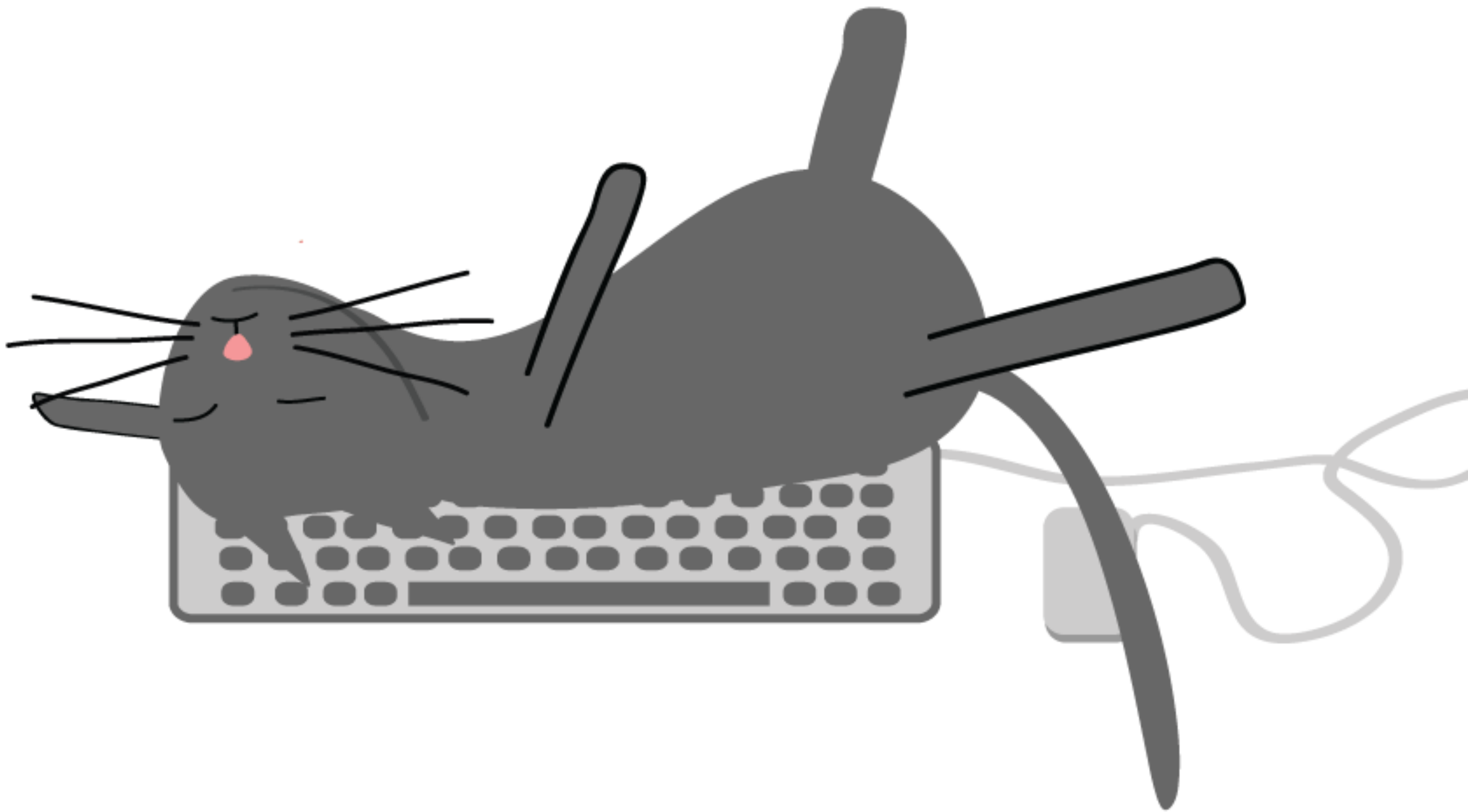

and mouse.

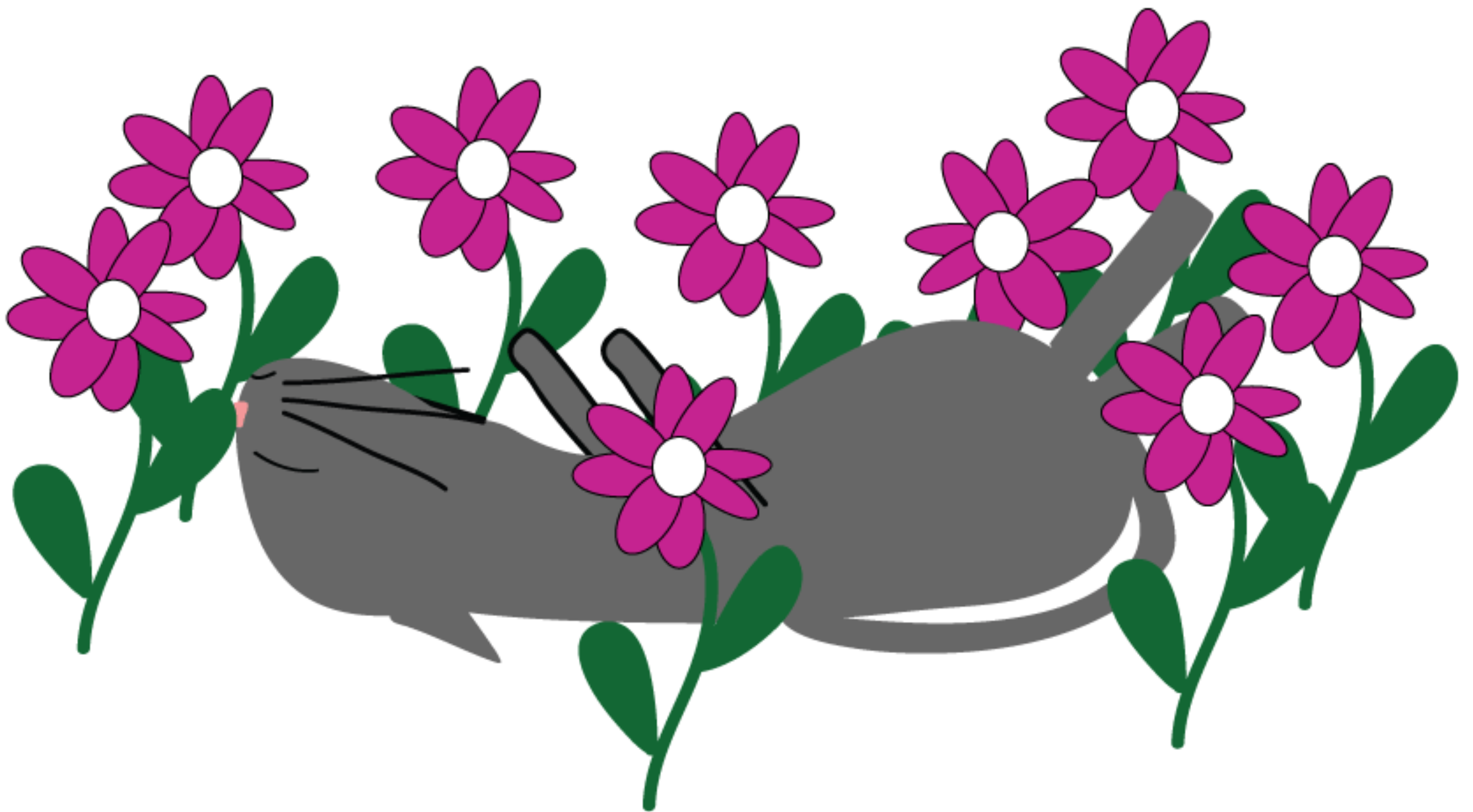


He will sleep in a box.

He will sleep in your socks.



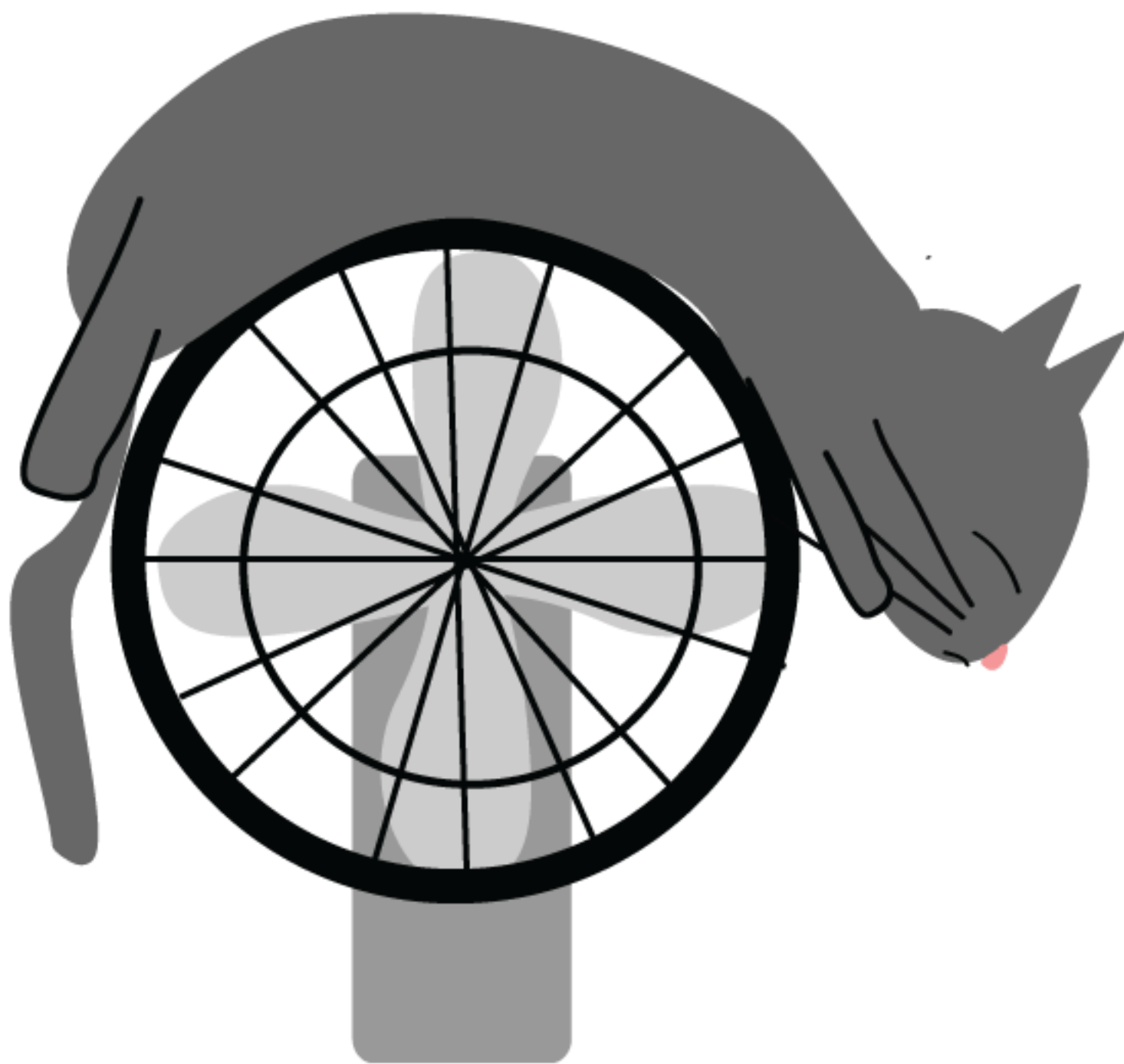
He will sleep in the shower.

He will sleep anywhere he can.

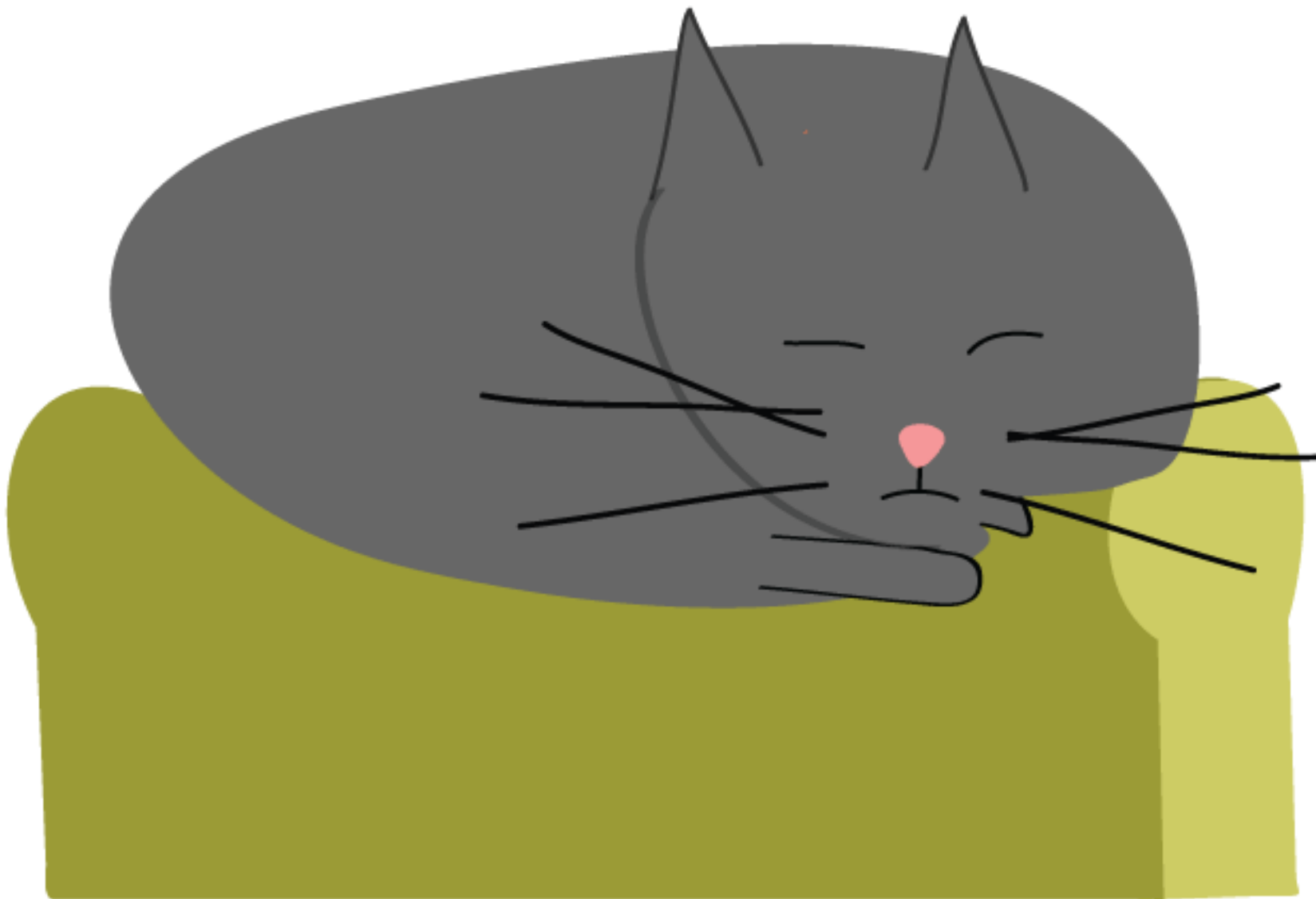


He will sleep on the bookcase.
He will sleep on your shoelace.

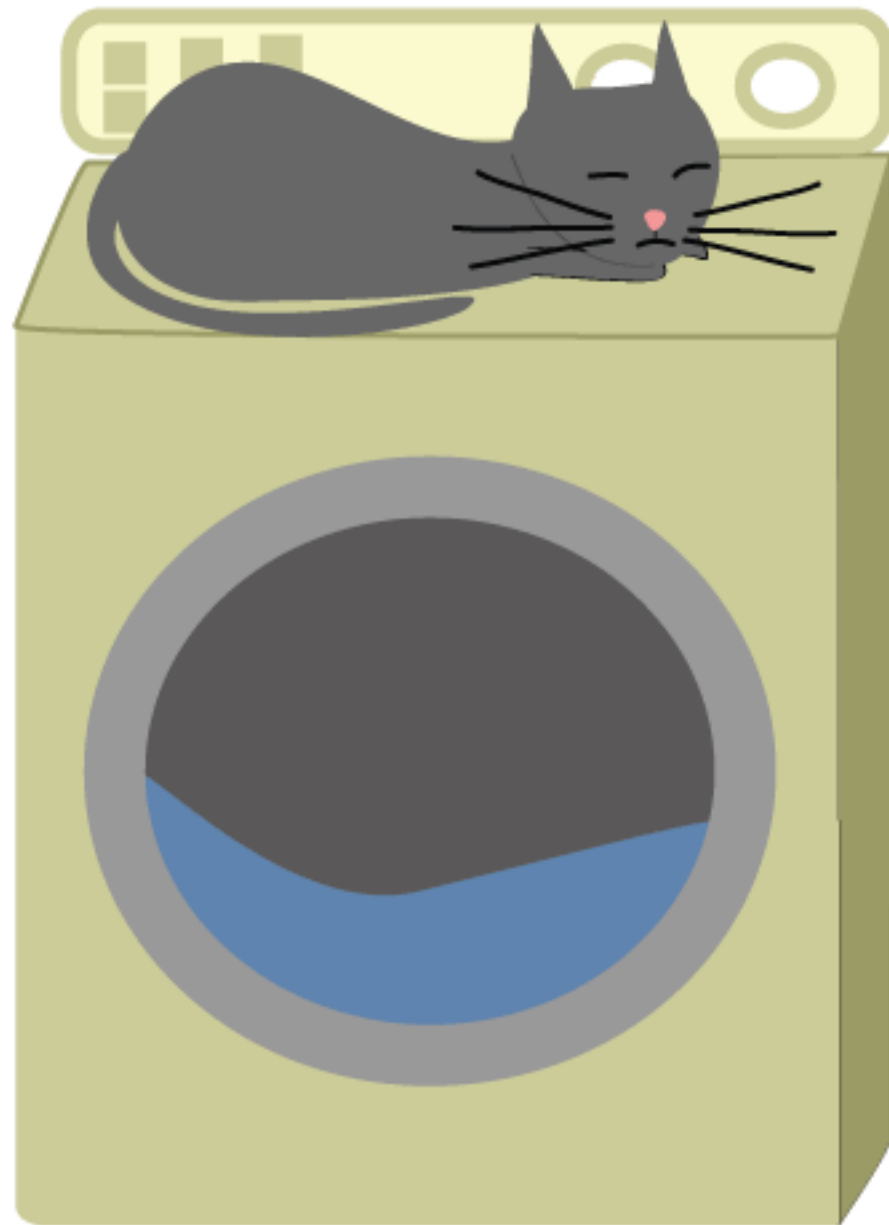


He will sleep in your freshly-made bed.

on your magazines.

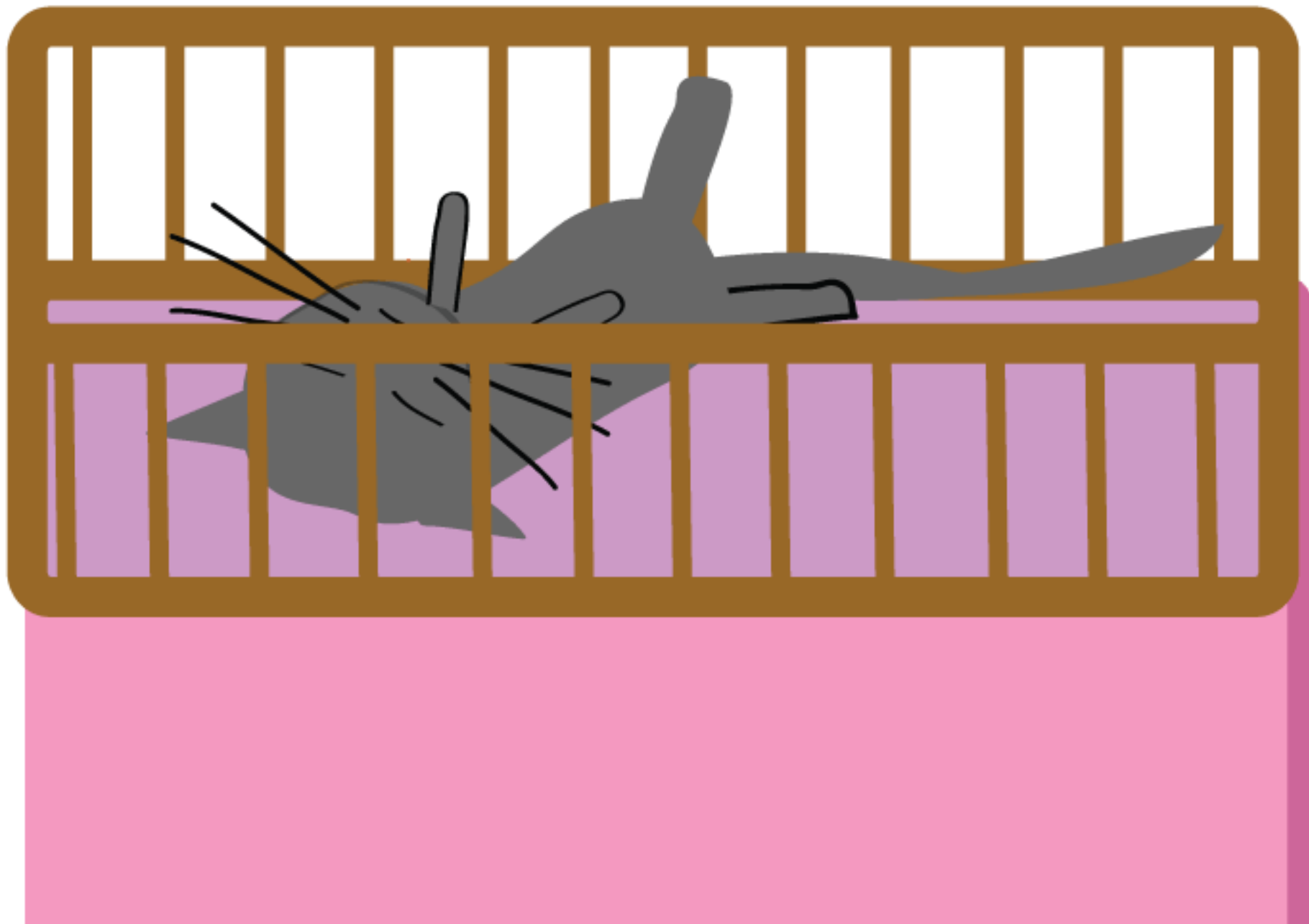


He will sleep in your hair

He will sleep 'most anywhere.

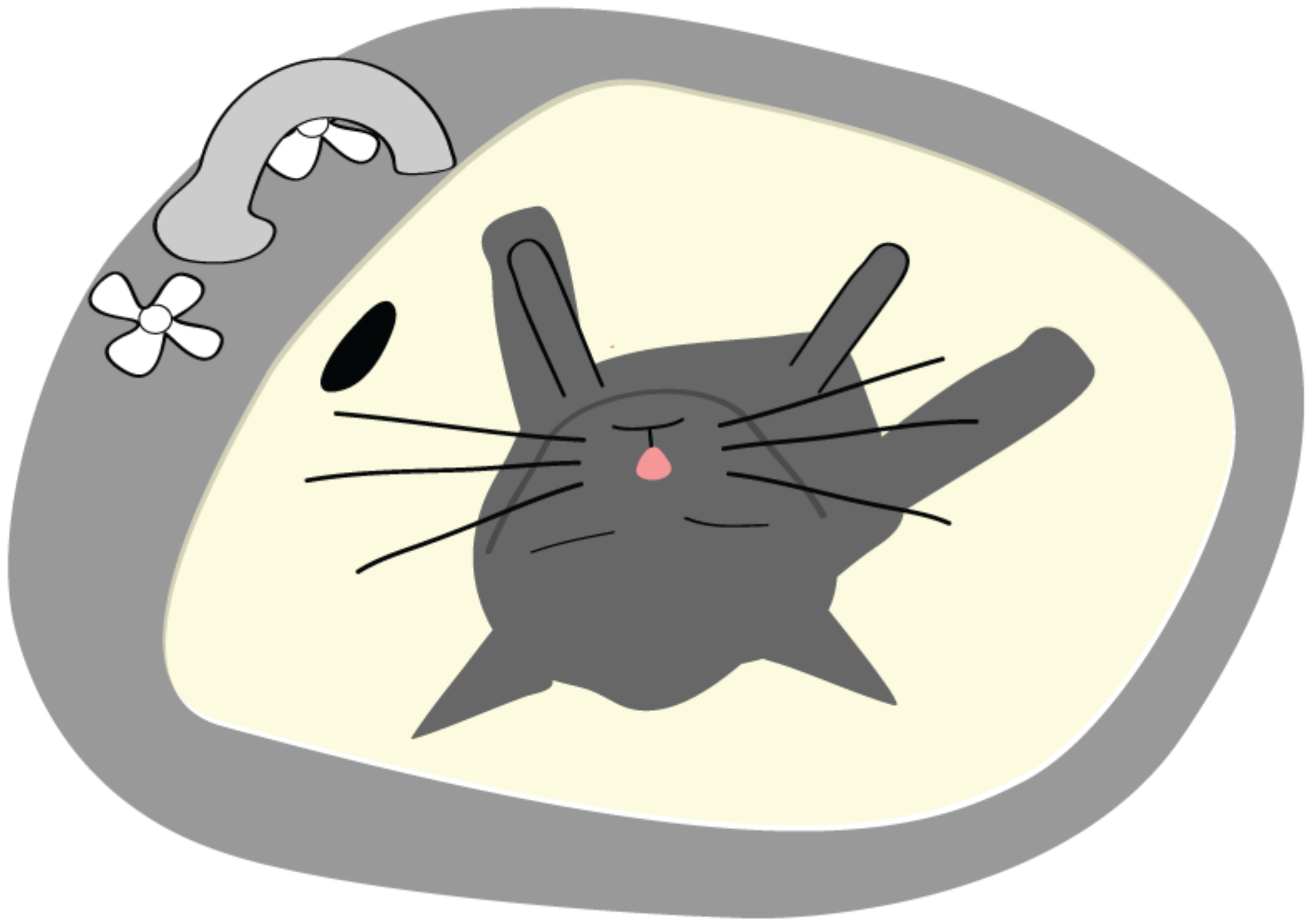


He will sleep on top of the kitchen cabinet.

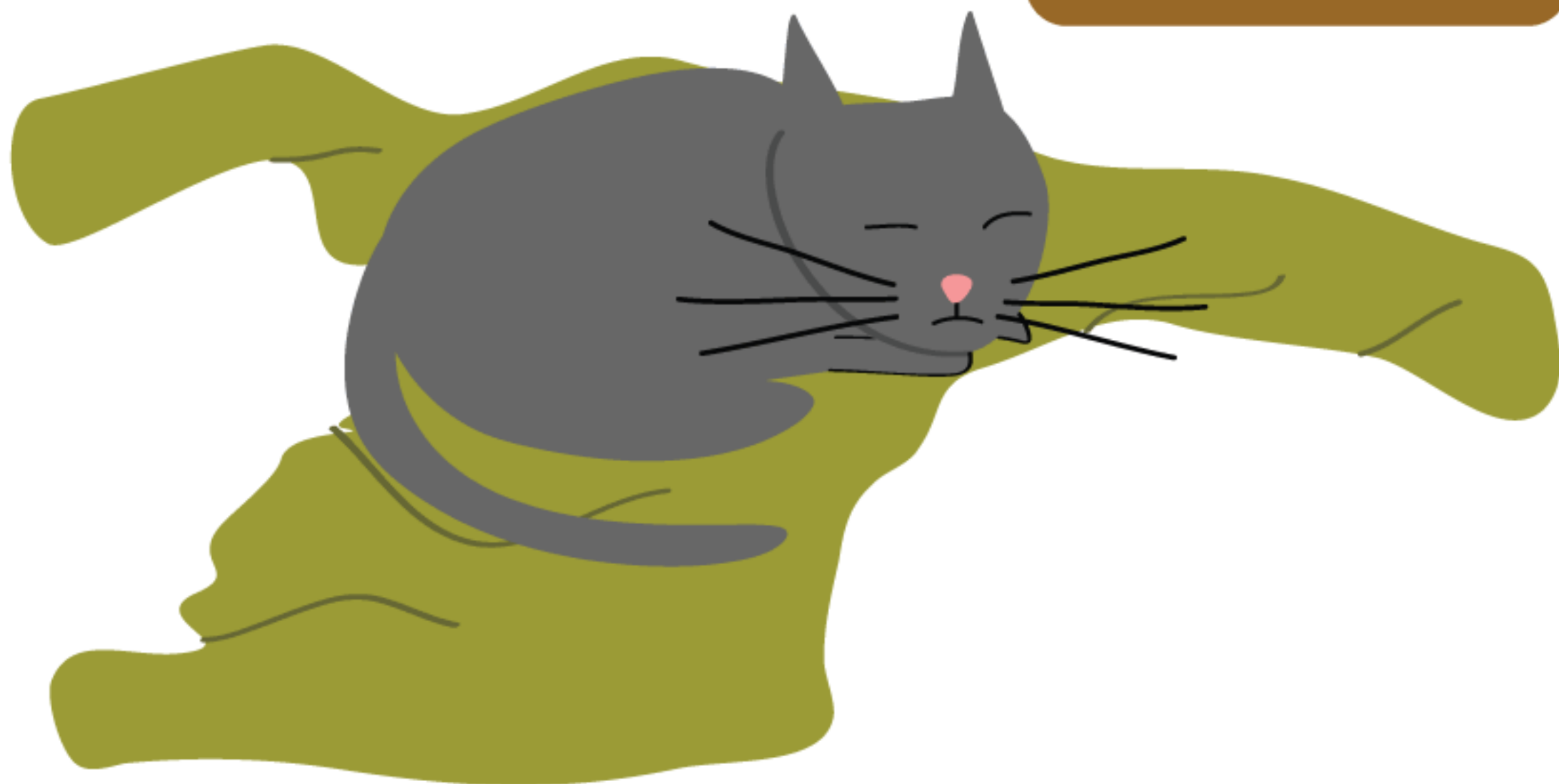
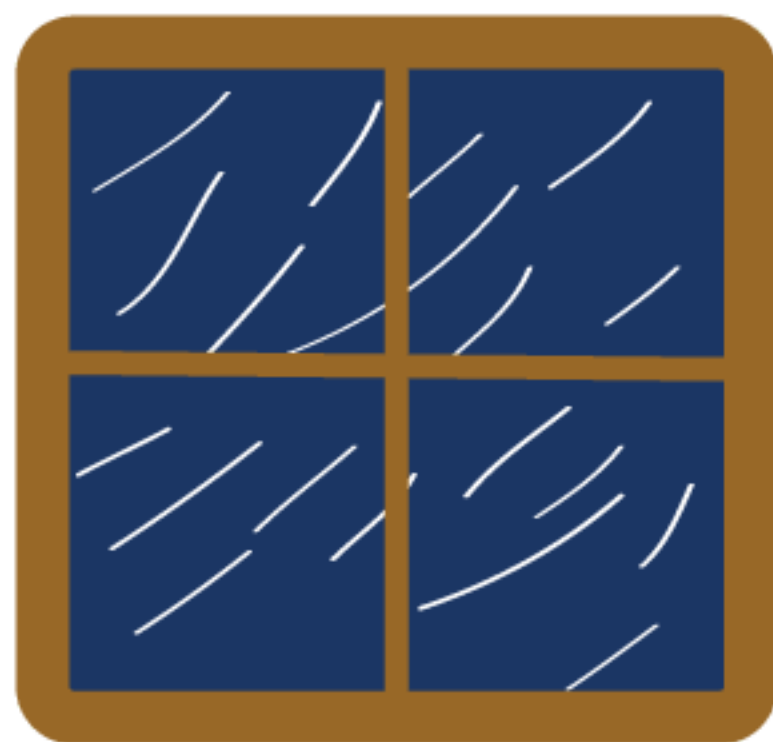
If you don't protest, he will sleep in the bassinet.



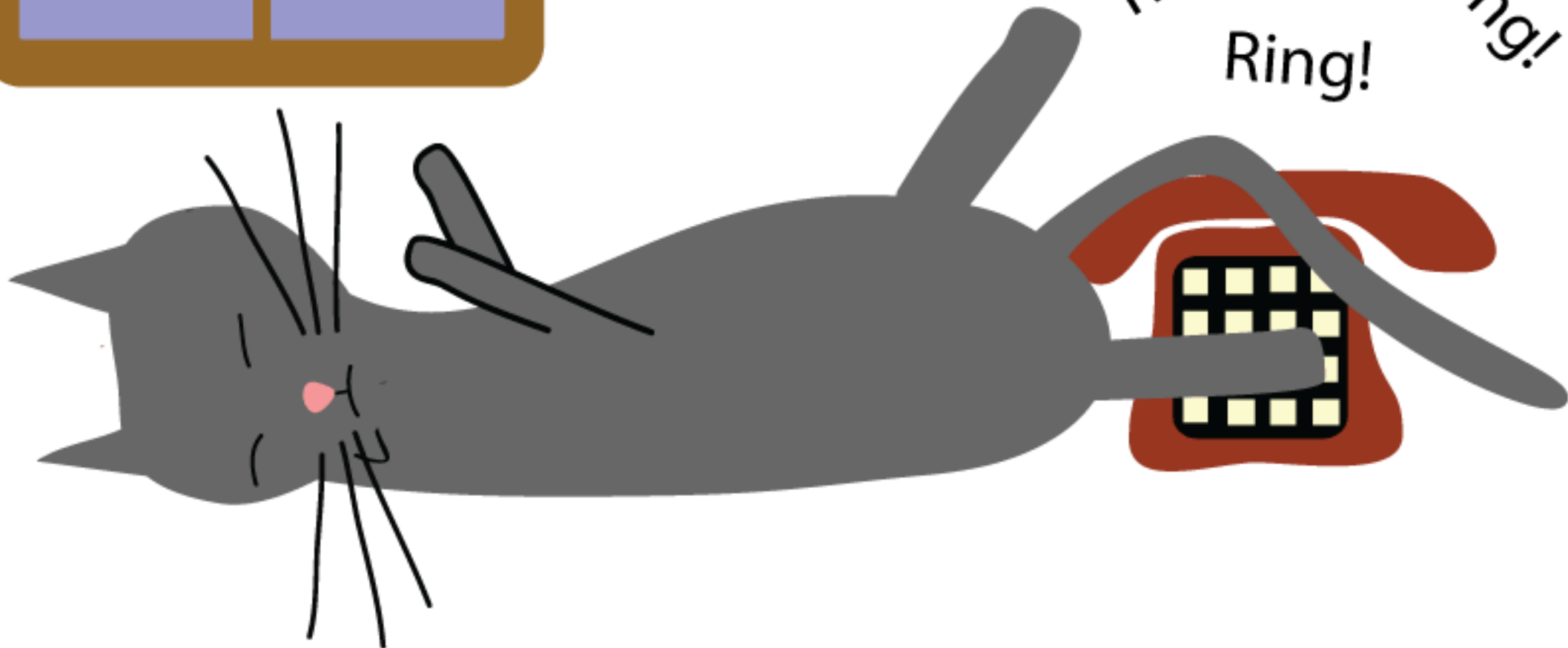
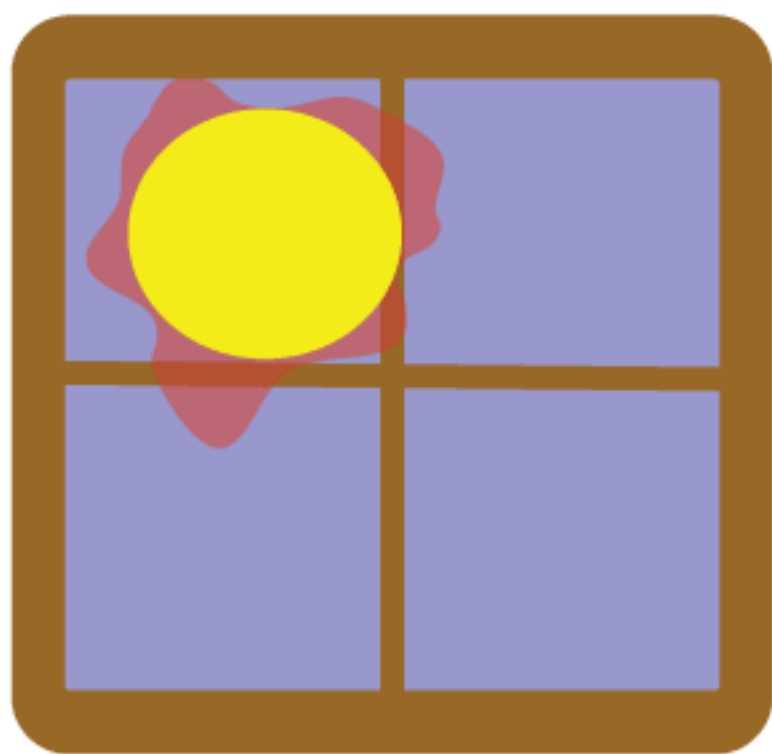
He will sleep in the sink
